"Juneteenth" becomes an annual celebration of emancipation. 1865	19	20	21	22	The murder of Vincent Chin, a Chinese American man killed by white autoworkers, activates Pan-Asian demonstrations highlighting the racism Asian Americans face. 1982	5-7,000 Chinese railroad workers strike for higher wages, shorter hours, and to deny overseers the right to whip and restrain workers to keep them from seeking other work. 1867
Sitting Bull leads native coalition to victory over invasion force led by presidential hopeful George Custer. 1876	26	Black artist/activist Bree Newsome climbs a flagpole and removes the Confederate flag at the South Carolina statehouse to protest the legacy of slavery. 2015	The Stonewall Uprising, led by queer and trans people of color, fights back against police harassment and launches the modern gay liberation movement. 1969	29	30
