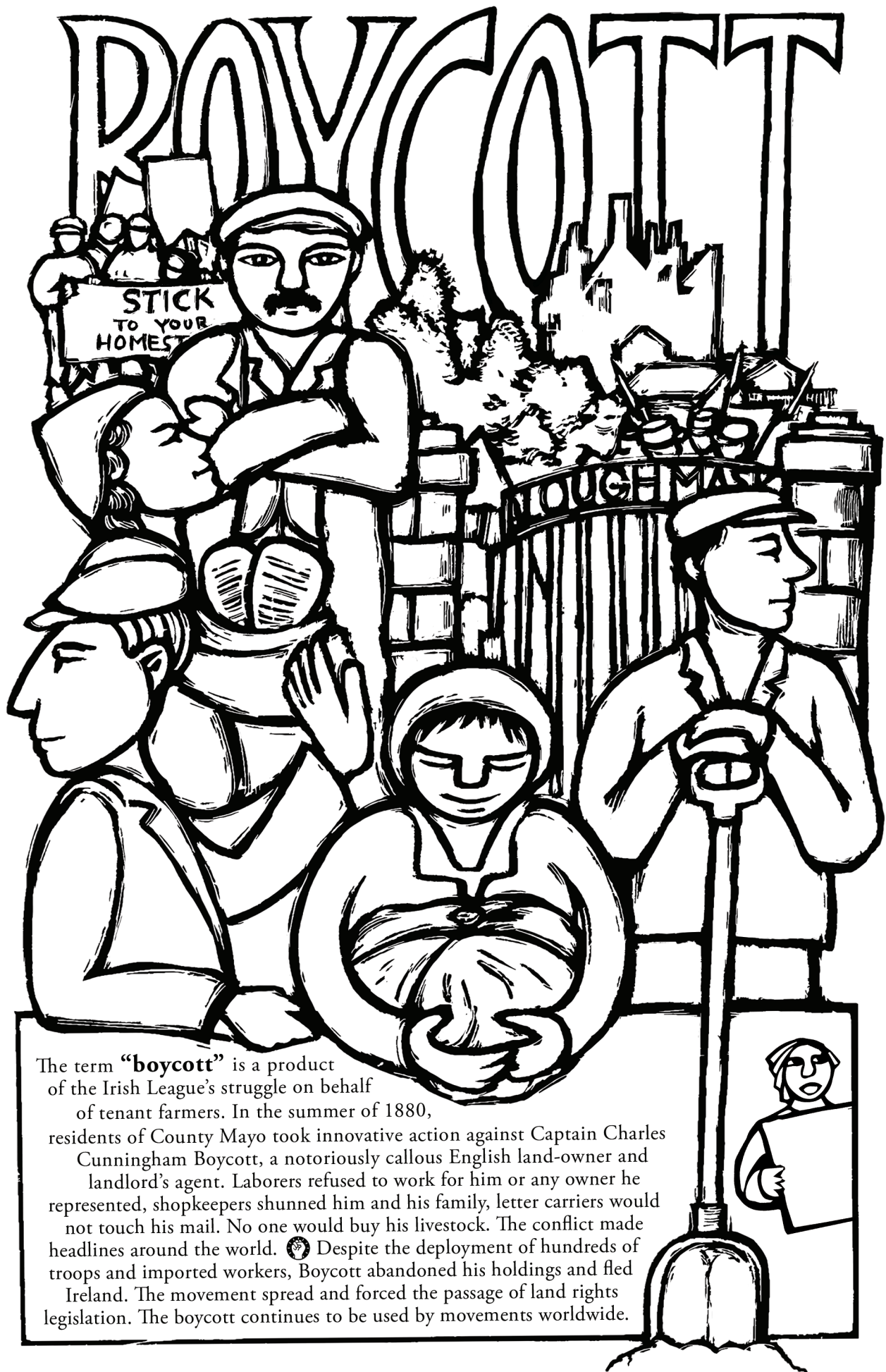

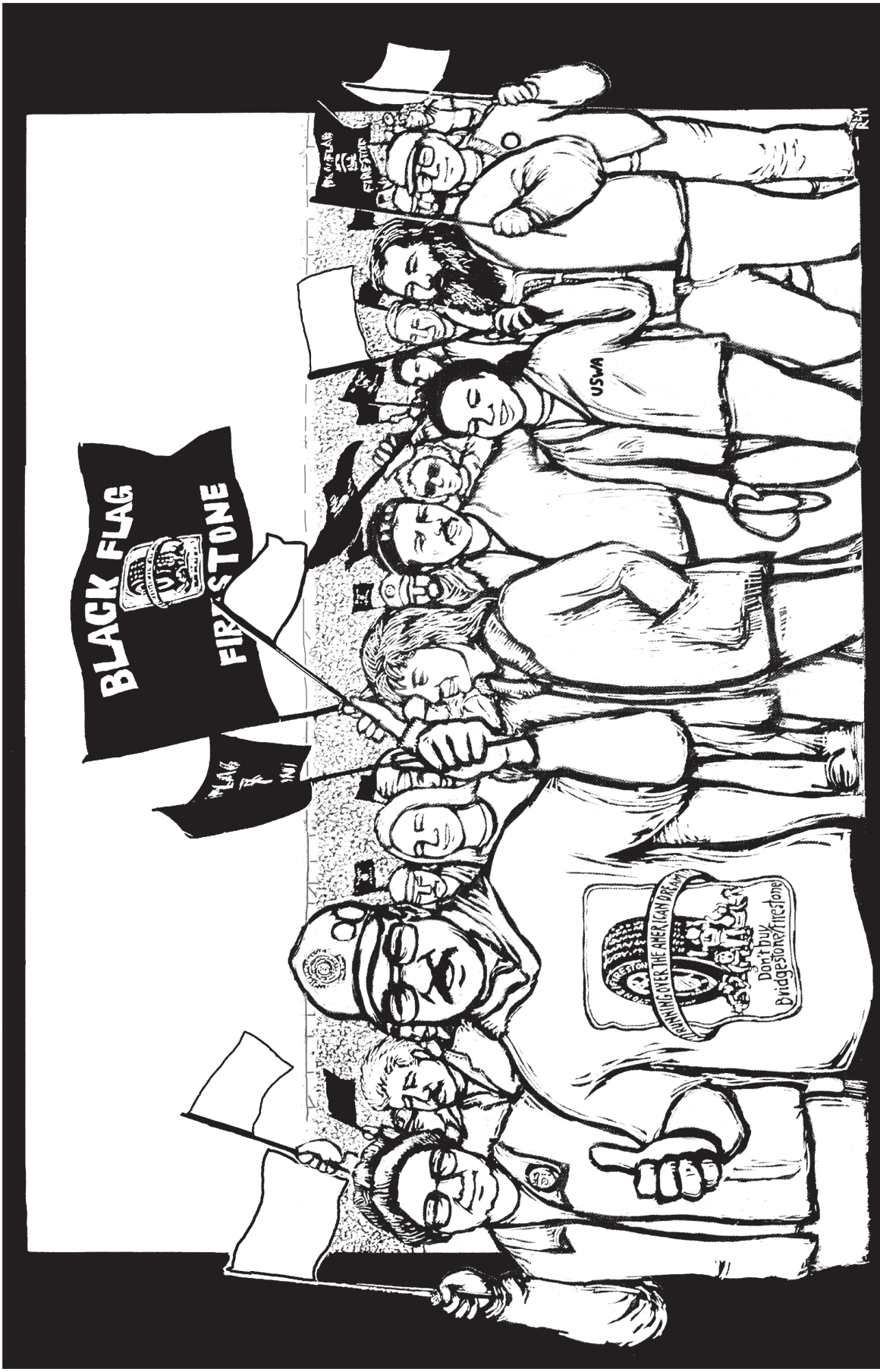

The term “**boycott**” is a product of the Irish League’s struggle on behalf of tenant farmers. In the summer of 1880, residents of County Mayo took innovative action against Captain Charles Cunningham Boycott, a notoriously callous English land-owner and landlord’s agent. Laborers refused to work for him or any owner he represented, shopkeepers shunned him and his family, letter carriers would not touch his mail. No one would buy his livestock. The conflict made headlines around the world. 🌐 Despite the deployment of hundreds of troops and imported workers, Boycott abandoned his holdings and fled Ireland. The movement spread and forced the passage of land rights legislation. The boycott continues to be used by movements worldwide.

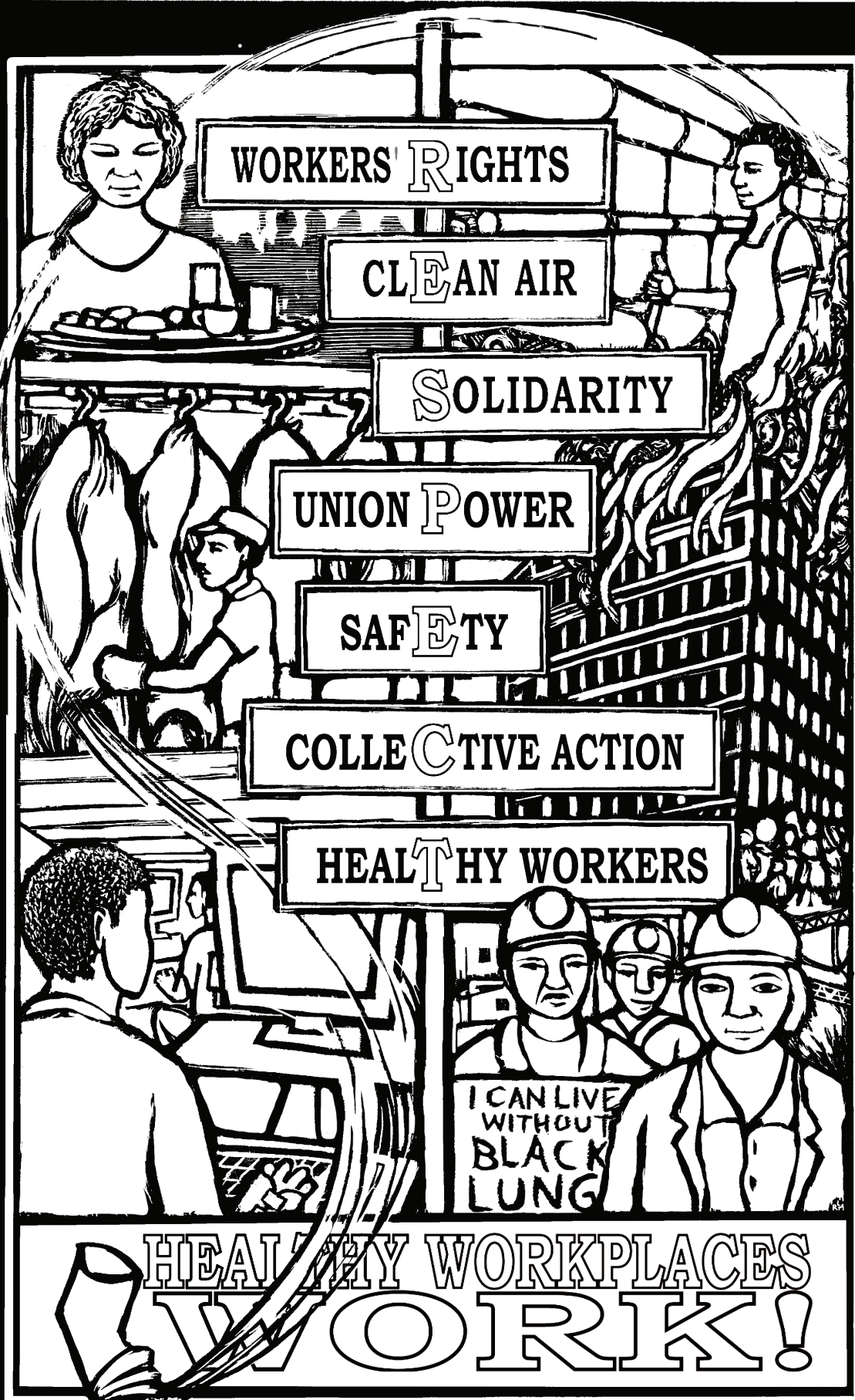


SOLIDARITY ACROSS OCEANS

This illustration commemorates the struggle of workers at Bridgestone-Firestone tire plants worldwide from 1994-1996. Workers went on strike for over two years and actions were held in 60 countries against the company. They won gains on nearly all major issues. The phrase "Black Flag Firestone" comes from auto racing, in which a black flag indicates a disqualification or unsportsmanlike conduct penalty.
